MACHKABBA GARDENS

In 2021, we were able to start a city sanctioned campground to serve people experience homelessness. We work in collaboration with Kabba Recovery to house and manage 29 8x8 shelters.



Over the course of the year 49 individuals were able to stay at MACHKabba Gardens.

13 of those who stayed with us, exited into housing.

PANTRY

Our Dairy Drive Pantry, established in August 2022, has been able to serve our community thanks to the generous support of Second Harvest Food Bank. In 2023, we distributed an incredible 16,472 pounds of food to our clients.

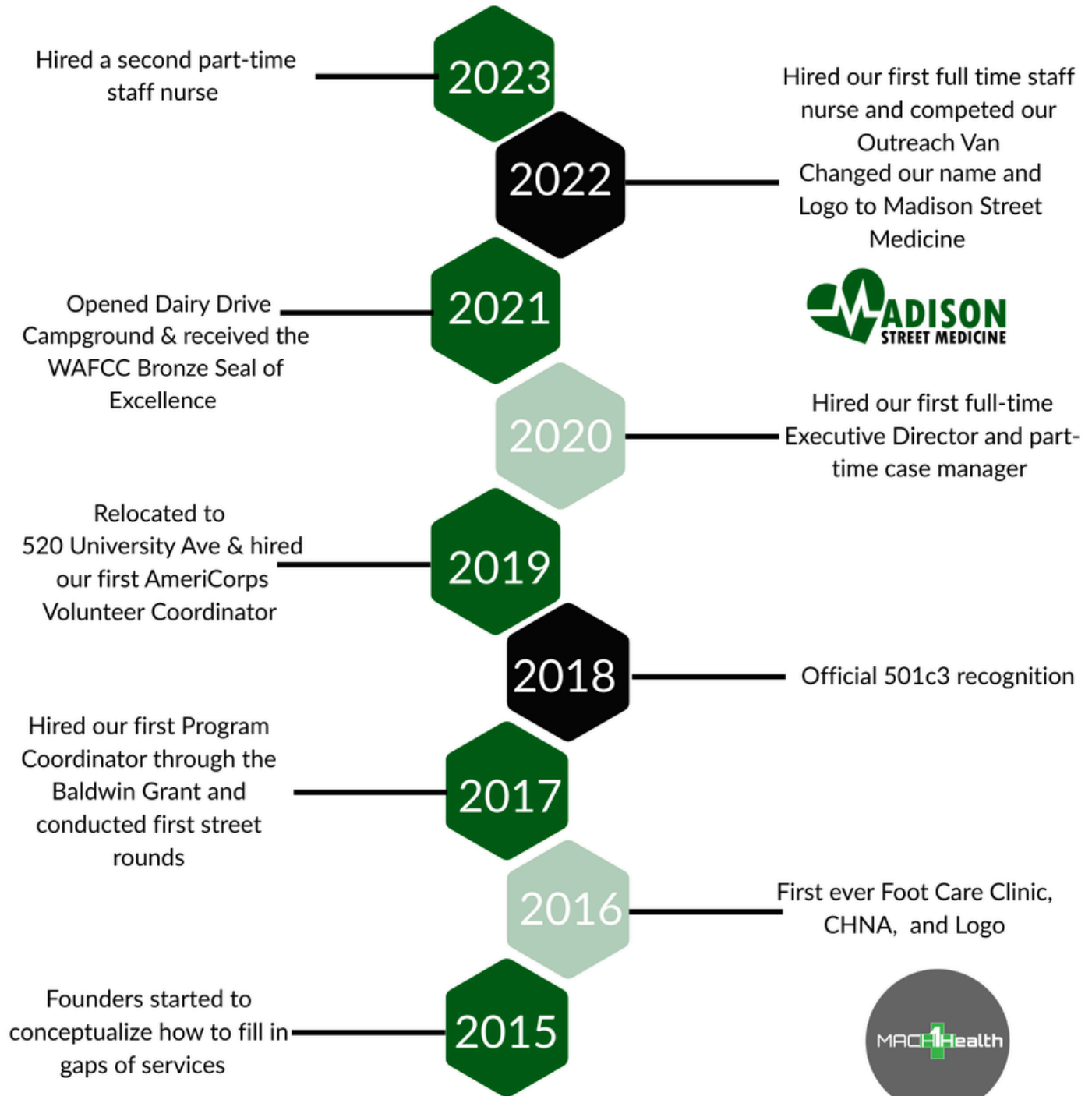

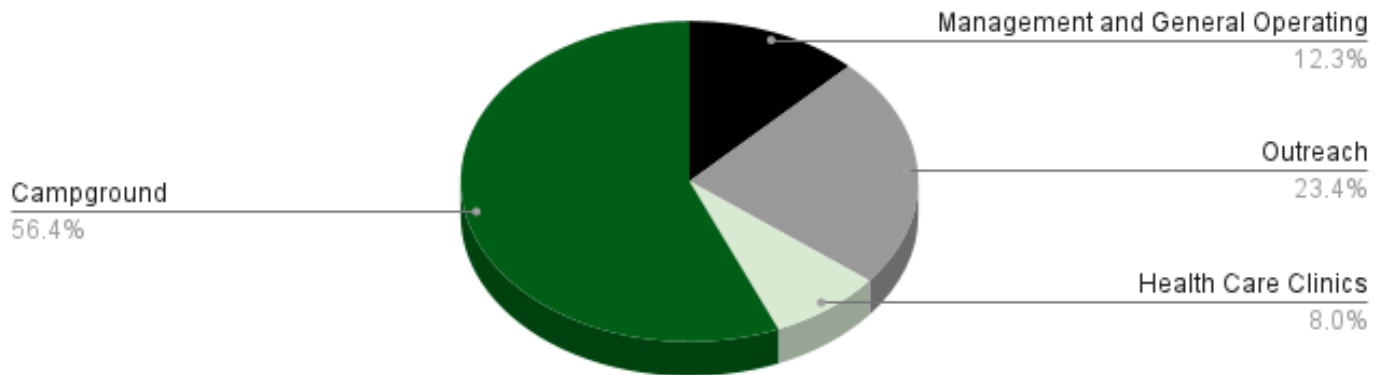

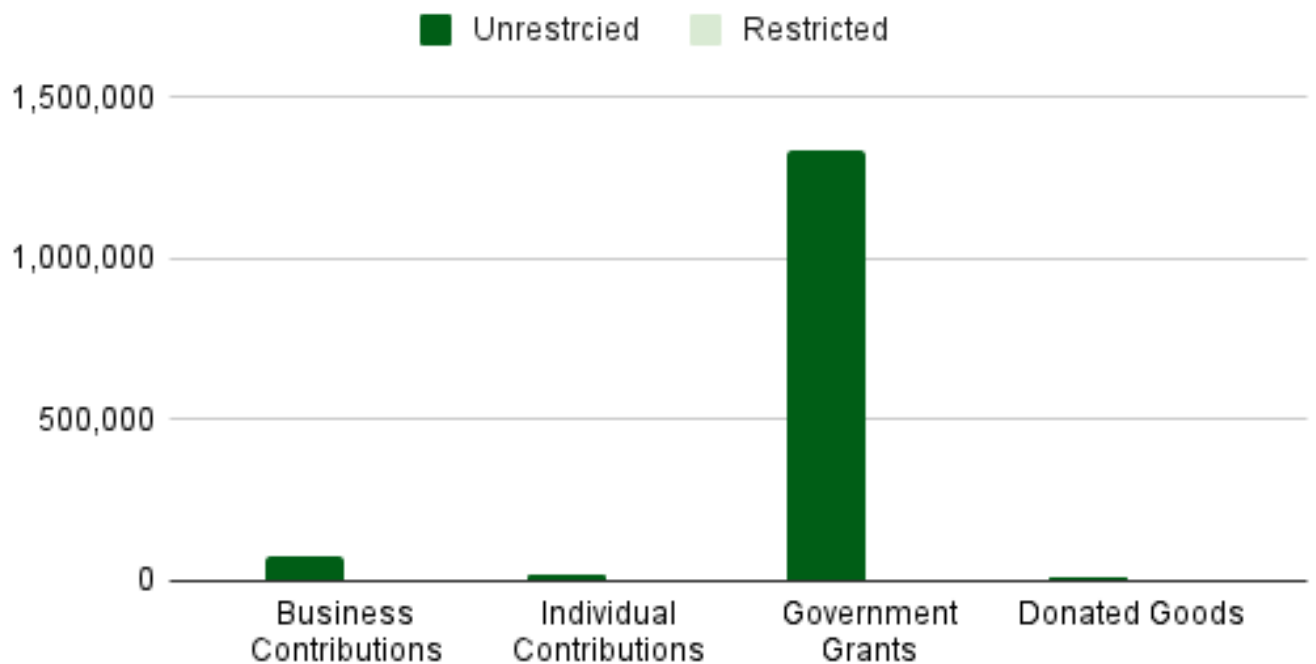
Total Expenses
