MACHKabba Gardens Update

We continue to manage our city-sanctioned campground which includes 29 8x8 shelters for some of the most vulnerable in the unhoused community. Whether you know this spot as MACHKabba Gardens or Dairy Drive, it undeniably has become a trusted spot in the community for accessing things like laundry services and bathroom utilities.



Thanks to our partnership with Second Harvest Food Bank, we continue to stock the Food Pantry at this site. Between the campground and our office, we supplied **17,149** pounds of food in 2024- a steady 104% increase from 2023.

2024 IN REVIEW

Harm Reduction Program + Our Public Health Vending Machine

This year we installed our first ever Public Health Vending Machine in front of our Williamson St. Office! This outdoor 24/7 vending machine is stocked with harm reduction supplies, lifesaving Narcan, drug testing kits, and personal + feminine hygiene products all free of charge. This vending machine provides clients and the community with a critical access point to essential services.

A direct result of the new vending machine, our Harm Reduction Program **DOUBLED** distribution of single needles and safer use kits, and **TRIPLED** distribution of Xylazine Test Strips from 2023!



Distribution Metrics

- 1,716** Boxes of Nasal Narcan (Pack of 2)
- 589** Injectable Narcan Kits (2 needles/3 vials)
- 16,530** Single Needles
- 1,838** Safer Use Kits
- 113** Xylazine Test Strips
- 289** Fentanyl Test Strips (# of bags, 5/bag)
- 1085** Condoms Packages
- 278** Tampon Packages + **182** Pad Packages

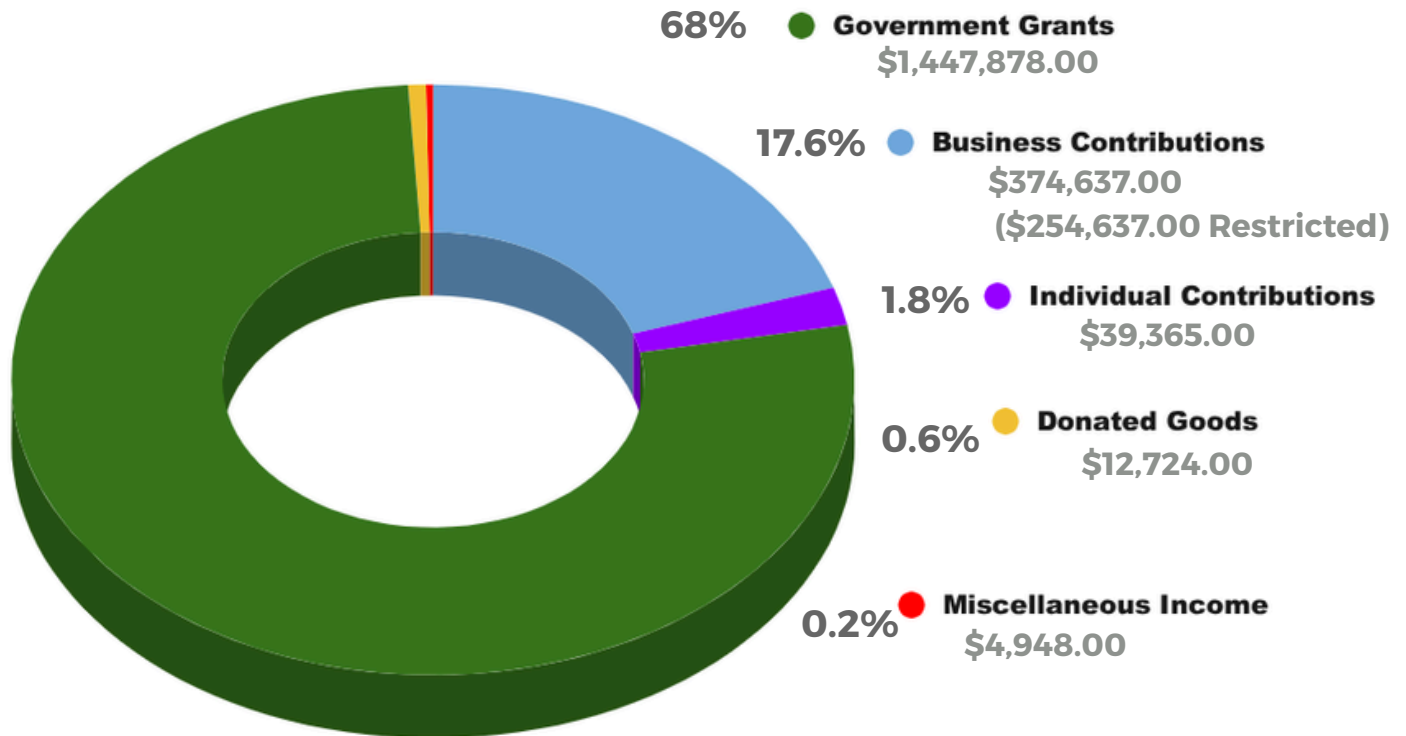

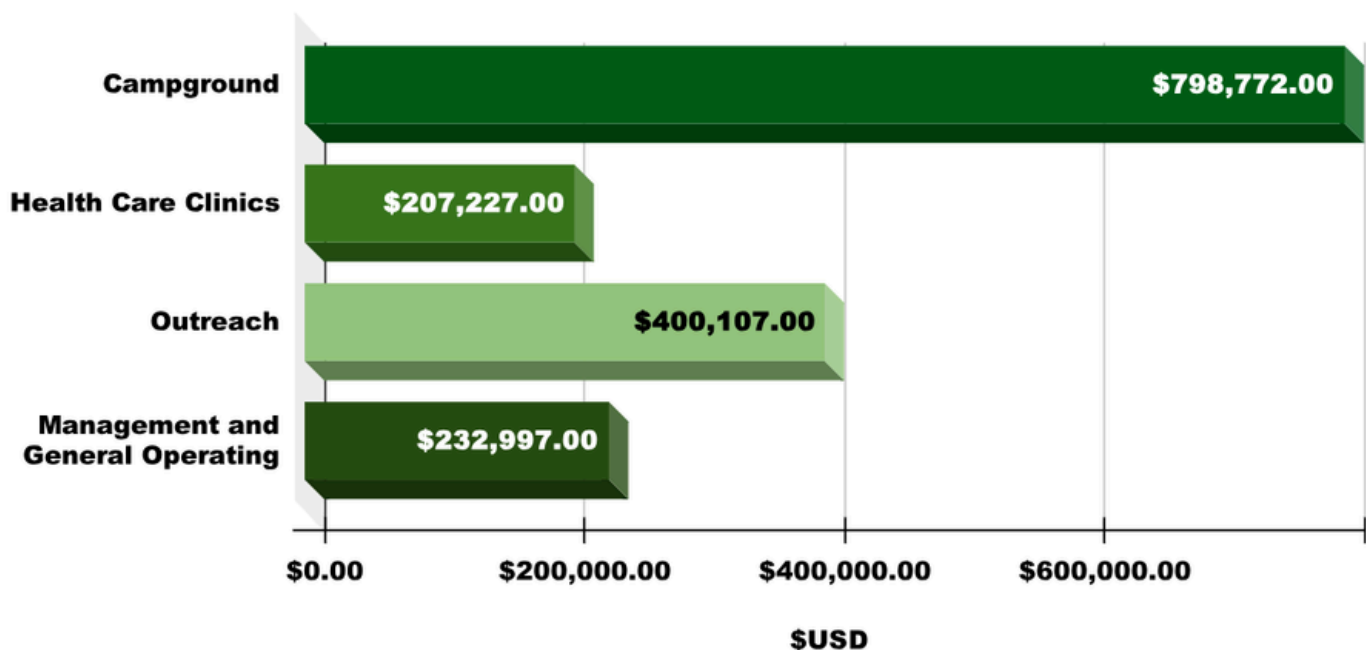
2024 Annual Revenue
